Mission First Housing Group began nearly 30 years ago as a joint venture between the City of Philadelphia, HUD and the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation to provide for the housing needs of adults living with serious mental illness. Today, Mission First is a family of nonprofit organizations with a shared vision to build communities where everyone can live independently with access to resources and opportunities in their community.

Resident Services


- Support residents to live independently, engage with their communities and achieve success.
- Provide a wide array of programs and services to residents, ranging from information and referral to a proven, education-based, anti-poverty program.


